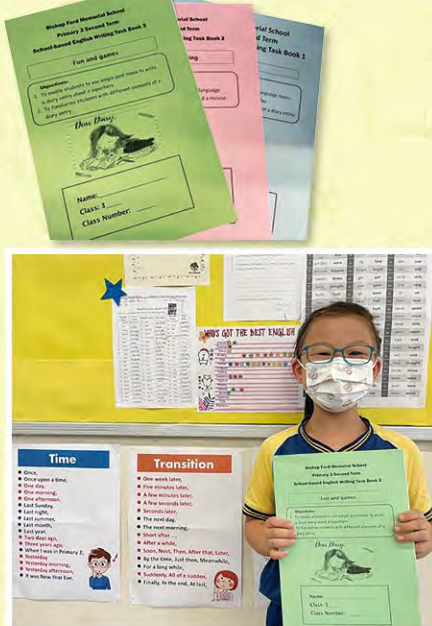

P3 Reading and Writing Support

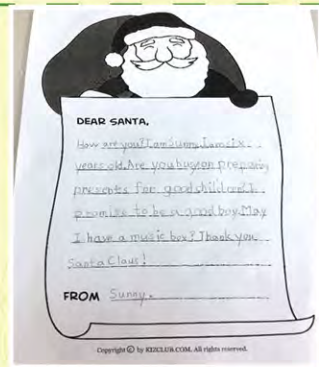

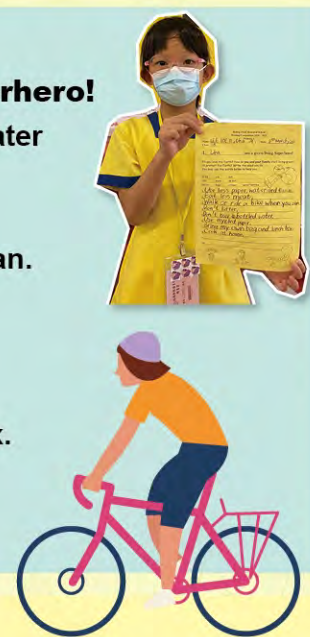
Writing competition 2021

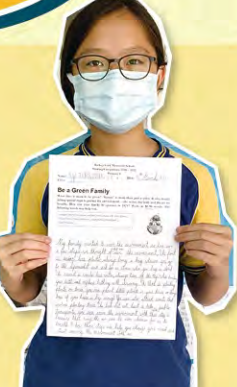
Today, I was amazed because we helped the Earth a lot.

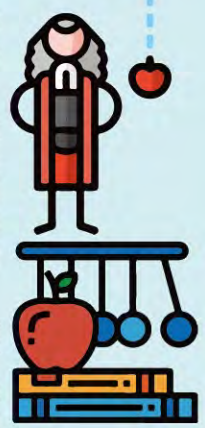
一位我尊敬的人

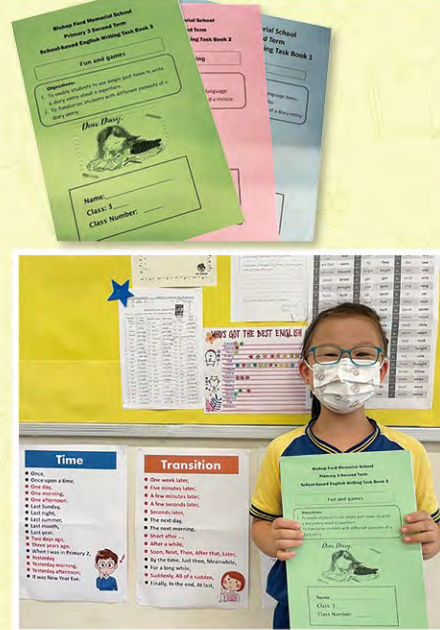

P3 Reading and Writing Support

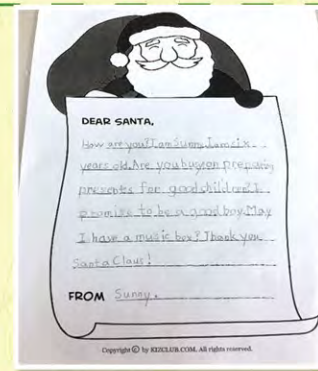

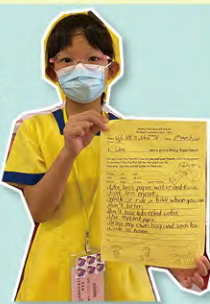

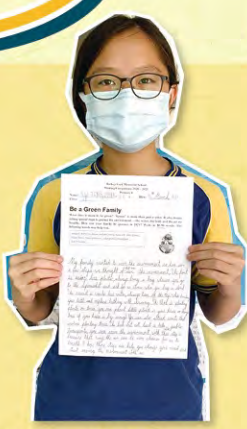
Today, I was amazed because we helped the Earth a lot.
