Students join various exciting joint-school events throughout the year and attend the graduation ceremony at the end of the year, where they put on a show with our students.

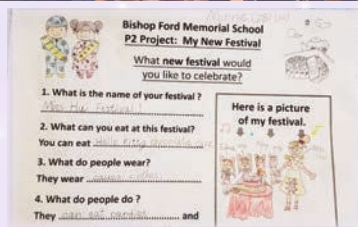


## NET Lessons

Then they attended after-school classes to broaden their understanding of the topic and develop their high-order thinking skills. I am happy with my restaurant. Do you like my restaurant? I hope you are scared to come here.



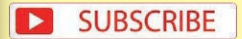
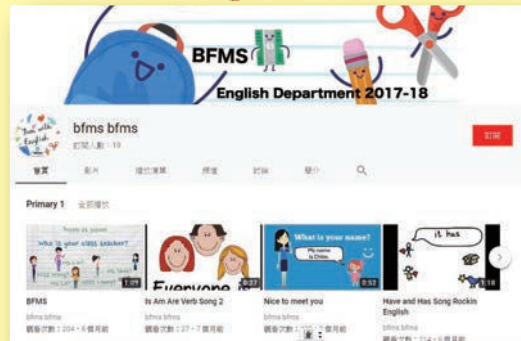
